The public of Serres will have the privilege to welcome one of the best American pianist of its generation, considered a master in New-York and other places, on his way for a tour in France.



Cyrus Chestnut started his musical career as a child and began studying classical music before directed his talent to Jazz composing and arranging. As a sideman, he began to play with some of the legendary and leading musicians like Freddy Hubbard, Benny Golson, Chick Corea, Betty Carter, Dizzy Gillespie and others, before a successful career as a leader. Influenced by his Gospel roots, he explores all the kind of Jazz music. He will play with three musicians who, each in his specialty, occupies a leading position on the current stage, the basist Darryl Hall and the drummer Willie Jones III and the trio invites the saxophonist Piero Odorici, the rising star of the Italian stage.

G rard Marais, guitarist and original composer which lyricism is celebrated, has form with this new quartet, around a emotive guitar, sometimes flamboyant, several generations of leaders of the current Jazz scene. On piano, J r mie Ternoy, eclectic composer who has explored all the issues and participates in numerous and various projects, from electric trio TOC till Magma. The drummer Christophe Marguet, whose first CD is rewarded with Django d'Or prize, is considered « probably the best drummer appeared in France for years » (B. Loupias - Le Nouvel Obs.). And Henri Texier, the great bassist and director who started his career with Kenny Clarke, Johnny Griffin and Bud Powell before starting the career everyone knows, and began one of the greatest names of current Jazz.

The group had been celebrated by the greatest jazzmen. It comes back to the stage with the same success. « one think to the pleasure Boris Vian would have had on listening to this emotional, comforting, loving music. It is our pleasure to rediscover it today... Vive the anachronistic France ! », wrote Michel Contat in T l rama.

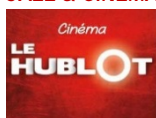
